



RODNEY SQUARE CONSERVANCY

The Rodney Square Conservancy (RSC) began in 2016 as a group of Wilmington residents and local businesses known as Friends of Rodney Square. They shared a commitment to creating a non-profit membership organization that could provide community pride in enhancing the physical condition of the Square and promoting greater use and appreciation of its historic legacy.

Within a year, the group was transformed into a non-profit participant representing the private element in a public private partnership with local and state governments. Its purpose remained unchanged – the restoration and improvement of the Square in the interest of civic pride and recognition of this public space as the civic heart of Wilmington.

Today, the RSC is spearheading the Rodney Square Works project, a multi-milliondollar renovation that began in August 2019. The endeavor will include a major aesthetic and infrastructure overhaul as well as the correction of deferred maintenance issues. Phase one of the project is expected to be completed in early 2020.
